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City of Clovis seeking public input on Parks Master Plan on May 16, 2017.

The City of Clovis is in the process of preparing a Parks Master Plan. We want to hear from residents, business owners, special interest groups, and any other interested parties. We will be hosting a public forum on May 16, 2017 in the community room at Miss Winkles Pet Adoption Center located at 85 N. Temperance Avenue starting at 6:00 pm. Everyone interested is encouraged to attend.

The Parks Master Plan will look at the existing parks system in the City of Clovis and determine how best to develop, promote, utilize, manage, and maintain a fully functional park system based on public input. The plan will prioritize the needs and desires for upgrading and improving facilities and services.

In addition to this public forum, a professional survey will be conducted. The results will be utilized to determine the priorities of recreational facilities and activities desired by our residents, what funding sources may be available, identify potential partnerships and how best to support the recreational needs of the community.
