## **SUBJECT: MANDATORY COMMERCIAL RECYCLING REQUIREMENTS**

The State of California has adopted mandatory commercial recycling legislation that may have an impact upon your business or multifamily residential units within the City of Clovis.

Assembly Bill 341, approved by the State of California, sets forth mandatory commercial recycling requirements statewide that become effective on July 1, 2012. The requirements include that businesses and public entities that generate **more than four cubic yards** of solid waste per week, together with any multifamily residential dwellings that consist of **five or more units** are required to arrange for recycling services in an effort to divert 50% of the waste generated that would otherwise be landfilled.

To arrange for recycling services, please call the City's authorized agent: Allied Waste at (559) 275-1551. You can also request a free waste-audit from the City's authorized agent where they will determine the size, quantity and location for your recycling service.

Please note that all commercial and multifamily residential dwelling customers that obtain recycling services must do so with the City's authorized agent.
